SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION: This solemnity is a holy day of obligation. Holy Family will have two Masses for this celebration on **Thursday, December 8th: 8 a.m. & 7 p.m.**

ADVENT EUCHARISTIC ADORATION WITH CONFESSIONS: There will be Eucharistic Adoration at Holy Family on **Thursdays, December 15th and 22nd from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.** Confessions will be heard during adoration.

CHRISTMAS MASSES: Holy Family will celebrate four Christmas Eve/Day Masses as follows: Christmas *Vigil* Mass at **5 p.m.** on **Saturday, December 24**; Christmas *Night* Mass at **10 p.m.** on **Saturday, December 24**; Christmas *Dawn* Mass at **8:30 a.m.** on **Sunday, December 25**; and Christmas *Day* Mass at **11 a.m.** on

Sunday, December 25. Each of these Masses has its own set of readings and prayers. Please note that *there will be no* confessions on Saturday, December 24, and *there will be* no 7 p.m. Mass on Sunday, December 25.
